Sleep Education for Everyone Program (SLEEP)

Sufficient sleep is essential for optimal health and wellbeing. The quality and quantity of your sleep affect the mental and physical health of people of all ages. The SLEEP program was developed by sleep researchers, a certified sleep medicine specialist, MSU Extension educators, and older adults living in the community.

A total of six, 30-minute sessions were created; topics for sleeping order by session include: introduction to sleep and health with a focus on recommended duration guidelines; sleep hygiene best practices, Stimulus Control Therapy, mindfulness and relaxation, relationships between sleep and physical activity, and sleep myths.

AARP Income Tax Program 2022

(Tax year 2022)

The AARP Income Tax program begins Monday, January 30, 2023. You may begin calling 810-785-2270, Wednesday, January 4, 2023, for your appointment. No appointments will be made before this date.

If you do not bring any of the following items that apply to your appointment, we will not be able to do vour taxes.

•Photo proof of identification

•Social Security cards for you, your spouse and dependents - all to be included on the return. An individual Taxpayer identification number (TIN) assignment letter may be substituted for you, your spouse and/or your dependents if you do not have a Social Security number.

•Birth dates for you, your spouse and dependents on the tax return.

•Copy of 2021 Tax returns

•Wage and earning, pension or other retirement income statements (Forms W-2, W-2G, 1099-R, 1099-Misc) from all employers/payers

•Brokerage statements

•Interest and dividend statements from banks (Forms 1099 -INT and -DIV)

•Health Insurance Exemption Certificate, if received

•A blank check for proof of bank account routing and account numbers for direct deposit.

•Total paid for day-care provider and the day-care provider's tax identifying number such as their Social Security number or business Employer Identification Number

•Forms 1095-A, B, or C Affordable Health Care Statements

•Social Security benefit statement

•Property tax statement if claiming property tax credit. Mortgage statements are not acceptable. Must have copy of property tax. You must go to your taxing body and pick up a copy of your property taxes (summer and winter of current year for property tax credit). We need the information on that sheet; the amount provided on your interest statement is not enough.

•Years Rent statement by the month, landlord's name and address if claiming Rent Credit

•Consumer's energy statements for the year if claiming Heating credit

•If you live in a mobile Home Park bring rent breakdown of how much is rent and water. Also name, and address of your landlord.

•Name and address of landlord if renting

Transportation Services

Let us do the driving for you!

If you need a ride to the center, doctor or grocery store and live in the Mt. Morris service area call Krapohl Senior Center at 810-785-2270 to schedule a ride. You must give at least 24 hour notice to be put on the bus schedule. Availability is based on a first come, first serve system. The Krapohl Center does not provide transportation for persons with wheelchairs.

RECEIVE A DISCOUNT WITH A TRANSPORTATION PASS:

A ride from home to the center and home again is \$4 which equals \$40 for 10 trips. A transportation pass is \$30 for 10 trips. That's a \$10 savings with the pass. We offer an additional stop pass for those extra stops, for \$10.

Riders who need to make additional stops are charged \$.50 per stop that is not on your direct route. For example, If a rider comes to the center and then stops at the bank and then the store, the fee would be: 4 + .50 + 50 = 5.00 or 2 transportation punches and 2 additional stop punches.




